POSITION PURPOSE:

Provide exceptional service to every person with whom there is interaction while assisting the providers with patient care especially in the procedure of taking x-rays, demonstrating commitment to customer satisfaction, professionalism and safety.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Set up exam rooms and set up patients in the rooms; ensure timely patient flow
- Perform x-rays of patients according to doctors'/physician assistants' instructions and protocol
- Assist the doctors and physician assistants, including aspirations and minor surgical procedures
- Complete procedures as directed: casting, splinting, setting up injections, changing dressings, removing stitches and staples
- Enter charges for all procedures and supplies on encounter forms

- Assist with doctor's calls
- Maintain supply of forms for doctors
- Handle receipt and faxing of information
- Accompany physicians to outreach clinics
